President Joe Biden announced\* that he would not be seeking re-election in 2024. This decision was, made public on July 21st, 2024, that the Democratic Party\* began to rally behind Vice President\* Kamala Harris as their primary\* candidate\*.

Kamala Harris is an American politician who is currently the Vice President of the United States. She is also the first woman, the first African American, and the first South Asian American to hold the office of Vice President in the U.S.

She was born in California in 1964. Her mother is of Indian descent\*, and her father is from Jamaica. Growing up in a multicultural\* environment helped her understand the importance of diversity\* and equality\*. From a young age, she was interested in politics\* and social issues\*.

She studied at Harvard University and then went to law school at the University of California, Hastings. She had several interesting experiences during her student years that influenced her future career. For example, while studying at Harvard University, she was actively involved in student organizations\* and community service. At the University of California, Hastings, where she studied law, she developed a strong interest in social justice and fairness. Her campus activities helped her learn and discuss these issues, leading her to a career in politics. These experiences during her student years played a big role in\* shaping her values and career path.

She worked as a prosecutor\* in San Francisco in the 1990s. As a prosecutor, Harris handled major criminal cases\*. Later, she became the Attorney General of California. She focused on crime prevention\*, consumer\* protection, and housing issues. In her political career, from 2017 to 2021, she served as a U.S. Senator\* from California. In the Senate, she worked on various issues like social problems, environmental issues, and the economy. In the 2020 presidential election\*, she was chosen as Joe Biden's running mate. They won the election, and she became Vice President. As Vice President, she has struggled\* to make better society through promoting educational opportunities.

Her career has focused on social issues and promoting fairness. She has been interested in social equality and fought for disadvantages. She will develop her careers for everyone and better society.
